

BIOGRAPHY

David J. Amado is a Jamaican-American Filmmaker-Choreographer, a Portuguese Ministry of Culture Grant Recipient and a graduate of Columbia University in the City of New York (B.A. in Music).

His films "Velveteen" and "True Colors" have been presented in film festivals such as the Berlin Lift-Off Festial, Afropolitan (Brussels) and Mostra Ousmane Sembene de Cinema (Brazil). David's work has also been featured in magazines such as Vogue Portugal, The Vanilla Issue (Austraila), Selin Magazine (Holland) and PARQMag (Portugal). Most recently, "Velveteen" and "True Colors" were broadcast on the television station RTPÁfrica, which brought the films directly into the homes of people in Portugal, Angola, Mozambique, Guiné-Bissau, São Tome and Cape Verde. Currently, David is in the process of developing his first feature length film through a screenwriting residency with Netflix Portugal and Academia Portuguesa de Cinema.

As a choreographer, his mission is to use ballet to tell the stories of black queer people. As a filmmaker, David is deeply influenced by the structure of the old 1970s and 1980s musical films, the aesthetics of 1990s American hip hop culture, as well as the writing of queer Black pioneers like James Baldwin. His work lies at the intersection of fine art, intellectual queer, and ghetto aesthetics. With a multicultural heritage and a career spanning three continents, David J. Amado approaches choreography and film with a nuanced, inclusive mindset where audiences are given the opportunity to expand their paradigm as it relates to the versatility of the Black body, as well as what is ballet.

"True Colors" 2022

Director, Choreographer, Executive Producer

A courageous ode to queer black men, which examines queer black men's relationship to the tradition of masculinity, and the ways in which societal expectations encourage those who exist outside the heteronormative standard to silence their voices, express themselves in a more "acceptable" way, and mute their true colors. With 4 acts of fashion, each act represents a different stage on the journey from repression to bold authenticity.

"Velveteen" 2021

Director, Choreographer, Executive Producer

Inspired by the book "The Velveteen Rabbit" by Margery Williams, "Velveteen" chronicles one queer black man's journey from self-hatred and repression towards self-discovery and acceptance. With dance and poetry, we follow our protagonist as he navigates ancestral trauma, racism and homophobia in order to heal himself, find community and live an authentic life unburdened by the expectations of others.

"Kaleidoscope" 2020

Director, Choreographer

A choreographed contemporary ballet trio for men which uses formations and visual effects to give the illusion of that the viewer is gazing into a kaleidoscope.

"Prism" 2019



CHOREOGRAPHY

Classical Ballet

Classical dance should be used as a transformational tool to help us build confidence and self esteem by showing us that we all possess strength, grace and beauty.

David J. Amado's classical choreographic work pulls from the Vaganova (Russian) tradition which places an emphasis on harmony of movement, athleticism and greater expressive range onstage. Detailed, individualized attention is given to each and every dancer resulting not only in improved ballet technique, but an increased consciousness of the body.



Contemporary Ballet

David J. Amado's Contemporary Ballet is an opportunity to transcend classical dance. It incorporates cultural traditions deeply rooted in the African diaspora, while borrowing classical lines and ballet vocabulary. Mobility of the spine and "groundedness" are the key components of the technique.

This fusion of the classical with the contemporary, and the European with the African Diasporic, creates an inclusive environment where everyone is welcome to cultivate their own language in the technique.

MOVEMENT COACHING

David J. Amado is also available for movement coaching and has extensive experience working with both dancers and non-dancers alike. He has lent his expertise and eye for elegance and grace to theatrical productions, commercials, fashion photo shoots as well as live musical performances.

CREATIVE DIRECTION

In one word, David J. Amado's style can be described as surreal. Through mastery of color, lavish composition and compelling narratives, David uses unique approach to creative direction as a means to push the boundaries of fine art, photography and film.

Conjuring images that are both highly imaginative and fantastical, David ambitions to use his work to showcase Black people, queer people, and other normally marginalized groups of society, in a majestic and supernatural way in hopes of shifting the cultural paradigm and changing the zeitgeist.

His work has been shown throughout Europe as well as South America, and he was also featured in Vogue Portugal.


